'*Sainte Catherine tout bois prende racine* – "on St. Catherine's day, the trees take root" refers to a good moment for planting roses. Actually, the feast of St. Catherine coincides with the "plant dormancy " which is a favourable condition for repotting and bedding out plants. Therefore, it is not a coincidence that our roses, which are grown under the BioDynamic principles, are sold in November to better take root and contribute to the good growing of rosaries. Since they are cultivated under natural principles, they have well-developed roots and can be bedded out in autumn – which season is better - and spring, proving themselves to be vigorous and highly floriferous. Our association is composed of genuine ordinary rose-lovers, who are always ready to answer your questions.
